For students aged 19+ who are eligible for our Access to Industry Award there is support available to help with the cost of travel through TMC Go.

TMC Go will not only help you with getting to and from College, it can also provide you with a way to explore all the great places in Greater Manchester.

TMC Go will operate on your college ID badge as a travel pass which you'll be able to use on bus transport only.

You can apply to get travel support through TMC Go if you meet our criteria*:

- You are fully enrolled at The Manchester College and doing a minimum of 10 hours of study per week
- · You are on benefits

and/or

Your household income is less than £25,000 per year**



- * Our TMC Go offer applies to 2023/24 only and is subject to available funds, terms, conditions and eligibility.
- ** Evidence is required.

All of the travel and parking schemes mentioned in this leaflet are subject to annual review in line with funding availability and each scheme will be reviewed and assessed before the start of each academic year. There is no guarantee that the benefits of any scheme will be continued from one academic year to the next.

How do I get travel support?

If you are eligible and meet our criteria then this will be discussed at the point of enrolment and you will be asked for evidence of income by showing either a P60 or wage slips. You may also be asked for proof of residency and required to show your passports or visas (etc.).

If you wish to appeal a decision, you will need to put this is in writing. You must outline why you feel the decision was incorrect and send your appeal letter to our Bursary Team within 10 days of the decision date. It will then go to an appeal panel and you will be informed of the outcome within 10 days.

HOW TO TRAVEL AROUND MANCHESTER

As well as TMC Go there are several other citywide initiatives to help students get across Manchester using public transport at either a discounted price or for free.

- Free buses run around the city every 10-15 minutes on weekdays and every 15-20 minutes on weekends.

- Choosing a combined Train and Tram Ticket allows you to travel free on Metrolink trams in Zone 1 if you have bought a rail ticket for travel from any Greater Manchester station to a city zone station just request a Metrolink add-on free of charge when purchasing your rail ticket. - Save 1/3 on rail tickets when you purchase a yearly railcard (£30 for a year)
