



If you've obtained the necessary entry requirements prior to joining us or during your time in our Centre of Excellence for Hair and Beauty, you can join our Industry Excellence Academy for Hair and Beauty where we offer our new Level 3 T Level and Level 2 T Level Foundation Year programmes.

Working so closely with employers means you'll benefit from courses that are aligned with current skills demands in industry and take part in a range of industry-level activities and lessons.

This will include masterclasses and lessons delivered by industry experts, visits from guest speakers at the forefront of the industry and opportunities to work on real clients that will enable you to develop the skills and confidence you'll need once you begin your career in the hair and beauty industry.

Once you complete your journey in our Industry Excellence Academy for Hair and Beauty you will have the qualifications you need to take the next steps towards an amazing career as well as the experience and skills that will help you stand out to future employers.



Study for a Technical Level (T Level) qualification in Hair, Beauty and Aesthetics

T Levels are a two-year technical programme that provide you with a high-quality alternative to A Levels.

They have been developed in collaboration with employers, and combine theory, practical and classroom learning with a minimum 45 day industry placement. If you opt to take a T Level you will spend 20% of your time on an industry placement and 80% in the classroom.

After completing the course you can progress directly into work, on to a Higher Apprenticeship or even go on to study a university degree, as T Levels are awarded UCAS points.



Courses

Level 3 | Barbering Harpurhey | Two Years

Are you someone who is interested in the barbering industry and always keeping up with the latest trends? Well, our Barbering T Level is the course for you.

You'll learn how to expertly analyse, shampoo, treat and condition the hair and scalp, creatively cut hair using a combination of barbering techniques, give advice on hairstyles and grooming, design, trim and shape beards and moustaches, and provide scalp, face and neck massages.

Level 3 | Beauty Therapy Harpurhey | Two Years

If you've got a passion for all things beauty therapy you're set to gain a wide-range of experience and knowledge with our expert tutors while studying a T Level. You'll cover topics including facial and body analysis and treatments, manicures, pedicures, eye therapy treatments, including lashes and brows, make-up application, Swedish massage, hair removal and more.

Level 3 | Hairdressing Harpurhey | Two Years

Are you someone who is always keeping up with the latest trends in the hair industry? Our Hairdressing T Level is the perfect way to kickstart your career. You'll learn how to expertly analyse, shampoo, treat and condition the hair and scalp, use technical precision and bespoke cutting techniques to create a variety of fashionable looks as well as colouring hair and carrying out bespoke colour conversions.

For those who don't meet the entry requirements and would still like to pursue a T Level, there is the option of a one-year Level 2 T Level Foundation Year as part of our Industry Excellence Academy for Hair and Beauty.

This Foundation Year will allow you to gain a qualification and move on to study one of our T Levels the following year.

Level 2 | T Level Foundation Year | Beauty Therapy Harpurhey | One Year

This is a technical qualification, which has been developed collaboratively with employers, professional associations and trade bodies to set the standard and content. You will gain the necessary knowledge, understanding and skills to complete the graded end of unit assessments for each unit, along with completing a graded synoptic assessment in the latter part of the qualification. You'll focus on a variety of techniques and associated benefits, and put into practice the knowledge required to treat a client.

Upon successful completion of the Foundation Year, students can progress onto the Level 3 T Level in Beauty Therapy the following year.

Level 2 | T Level Foundation Year | Hairdressing Harpurhey | One Year

This qualification is creative, challenging and very practical; perfect if you're passionate about hair in a world where styles are constantly changing. You will be encouraged to explore your inner artist as we work with you to achieve the skills, techniques and knowledge required to work in this stylish profession.

Upon successful completion of the Foundation Year, students can progress onto the Level 3 T Level in Hairdressing or Barbering.

Jump Start to T Levels

Both our T Level and T Level Foundation Year require you to complete our Jump Start to T Levels programme as an entry requirement.

This programme is a two-week introduction to our Industry Excellence Academy, T Level and Foundation Year programmes, where you can meet your tutors and experience what studying a T Level at The Manchester College is like.

Working together to achieve your goals, our Centre of Excellence will provide you with the knowledge, skills, experience and employability to start to shape your future and take the first steps into this fresh and exciting environment.

Study Programme

You'll join our Centre of Excellence for Hair and Beauty when you enrol on any of our qualifications from Entry Level to Level 3.

If you haven't already obtained a Grade 4 GCSE or the equivalent Functional Skills at Level 2 in English or maths, you'll study to achieve this level of qualification alongside your course. If you have a Grade 3, you will study a GCSE resit.

Alternatively, if you have anything lower than a Grade 3 then we will help you to develop your English and maths through Functional Skills.

This is a mandatory requirement and it's also essential that you achieve this for many careers and universities.



Employability

To prepare you for your future career, you'll take part in a range of 'employability' activities to equip you with the knowledge and experience of careers available to you.

Employability Sessions

You'll be assigned an Employability Tutor and will take part in dedicated 'employability' sessions which will help equip you with the skills you'll need to thrive in the workplace.

Work Experience Placement

If you join our Centre of Excellence you'll spend between 24 and 35 hours working in external workplaces across the region, while if you join our Industry Excellence Academy you'll complete at least 105 hours of work experience.

During your work experience you'll assist with day-to-day tasks and shadow staff to develop your skills and broaden your knowledge of the industry.

Industry Placement

You may be able to apply for an industry placement offering more than 315 hours of experience with a leading employer.

An industry placement gives you in-depth knowledge of the industry, allows you to gain hands-on experience and gives you an insight into career pathways.

With a placement, you're taking that all important first step onto the ladder; many of our students even go on to gain paid employment with their industry placement employer at the end of the year.

This is a two-year course, that allows you to progress onto a one-year (Top-Up) degree to obtain an honours degree.

Top-Up

This is a one-year course for qualified Level 5 students to gain an honours degree.

BA (Hons) Make-up Artistry - One year

A higher education qualification usually taking one year to complete, and roughly equivalent to one year of university study.






