Our employer partners at Northern Lights Gaming have talked to us about what it takes to succeed in the Mobile Gaming industry:

What would you say the top 3 skills are to succeed in the Mobile Gaming industry?

Practical knowledge should include; after effects suite (e.g. Photoshop); Spine (or another 2d animation package) and 3d software (any current package)

Technical skills should include, a good eye for what looks good design-wise; understanding of layout, size and scale of elements that make up a screen

In terms of transferable skills, we value candidates who can work independently and are able to juggle multiple tasks at once

What do you look for in a top candidate, when you recruit?

Confidence, general art skills and a creative eye for detail. Also, someone who shows willingness and drive. We recognise that college leavers won't have the same level of skills as a university graduate or somebody with professional experience and so a willingness to learn and underlying talent is key.

Why do you think work experience is important for college students?

In our industry a degree is no longer as essential as it used to be and so job applicants for a junior position can range from people with experience, no experience and also a range of educational achievements. A work placement, especially a long one like 50 days, shows you have all the skills you don't learn at university; working professionally, file structures, reporting to a manager, time keeping, team work ability, all round professionalism etc.

What is the best thing about working in the Mobile Gaming industry?

The variety of the work; You do all parts of a game; sketching and concept work, animation, 3d, 2d, vfx etc. In video gaming you will only do a tiny piece of a massive project

It's rewarding seeing your game go live and advertised on TV, the internet etc.
