

The creative and digital media sector is incredibly diverse – there are so many opportunities open to you if you have the talent, abilities and drive to succeed.



FINANCE EXPLAINED

Greater Manchester and National Skills Fund

Finances shouldn't be a barrier to your success and there are lots of course funding opportunities available to you at The Manchester College. In this issue, we're shining a spotlight on the new Greater Manchester and National Skills Fund.

What is it?

As part of the government's Lifetime Skills Guarantee, the National Skills Fund has been made available to help adults access qualifications regardless of your financial circumstances. In addition to this, the Greater Manchester Combined Authority has also provided funding to extend the offer of free qualifications available to adults.

Any eligible adult who has not previously achieved their first or second* full Level 3 or equivalent qualification will have the opportunity to access a wide range of free courses that will allow them to develop new skills to improve their career prospects.

The qualifications have been carefully selected to help you improve your job prospects. They have good salary outcomes and address skills needs in the UK economy, delivering a wide range of skills in many jobs and sectors.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible for a fully-funded course, you must meet the following eligibility criteria.

Greater Manchester Skills Fund:

- You are aged 19 or over
- This is your first or second Level 3 qualification or equivalent

National Skills Fund:

- · You are aged 24 or over
- This is your first Level 3 qualification or equivalent

How do I apply?

There is no need to apply separately for this funding, as this will be done during enrolment. Simply head to **tmc.ac.uk/adults** to find out more about our courses and how to apply.

Other Funding Options

Advanced Learner Loan

If you're aged 19 or over and you're starting a Level 3 or Level 4 course with us, you can take advantage of this loan which can be used to pay some or all of the tuition fees for your course.

19+ Study Programme Award

If you're aged 19-23, you may be eligible to access funding support through your legal entitlement to a full Level 2 or 3 qualification. If you're aged 19 or over, you may be eligible for funding support depending on your employment situation and/or income.

Tell us a about your experience in the industry and education

I have Bachelor and Masters degrees in Computer Engineering, many vendor qualifications from Cisco and Microsoft and a Postgraduate Certificate in Education.

I have been teaching at The Manchester College for almost nine years where my main subject area is Computer Networking.

In 2016, I received the Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) Instructor Trainer certificate, which enables me to train IT teachers/lecturers to become CCNA instructors.

Here are our top tips on how to perfect your Halloween look

1. Start with a clean face

Use toner to remove facial oil and rinse with cold water to minimise pores

2. Use Vaseline on your brows

If you're covering up your eyebrows, or you want to draw new ones on entirely, cover them up using Vaseline to keep pigment out.

3. Allow your paint to dry

If using different colour face paints, allow one colour to dry before applying your next. This prevents the colours from bleeding into each other.

4. Make-up can be used to create a texture

Brushing with a make-up brush will offer a smooth look, whereas dappling with the brush can generate a more interesting appearance.

5. Set your make-up

Sweat can ruin unset make-up. Setting powder, setting spray or even baby powder are effective ways to maintain your make-up.

STUDENT SPOTLIGHT



We met with Marcia Harding, an Art and Design student based at our Fielden campus, to find out more about her experience studying with us.

Why did you choose this course?

I decided to study Foundation Art because I'd been doing a lot of classes and workshops for a few years and I thought that I'd quite like to take it further and do it more full time.

What have you enjoyed most about your course?

I've absolutely loved the course here. I think one of the things I've enjoyed the most is the opportunity to experiment, try out and explore. I've done things that I've never done before such as light paintings and photography, scanograms, drawing with different mediums and doing life drawings.

Why did you choose The Manchester College?

I chose The Manchester College partly because I'd made a late decision that I wanted to do the course and I didn't have to go through UCAS to get in. Also, it's about a 10 minutes' drive from where I live in south Manchester, so it just worked out brilliantly. When I came to see it and had an interview and I saw the facilities, I thought, "Yeah I want to be here".

What are your plans for after the course?

At the end of this course, I've decided I don't want to stop being creative and I don't want to stop doing art and design.

I haven't quite decided whether I want to apply for a university course yet, although that's definitely an option, but I'm certainly going to pursue it and keep going.

This course has made me feel that I can do things. A year ago, I was so nervous showing things to other people and drawing things that other people would look at, but now I'm feeling a bit more confident, learning more, and developing.

Would you recommend The Manchester College?

I would definitely recommend The Manchester College, particularly for the art and design course, which is the one I know about. For me, the facilities are just fantastic, there's so many opportunities to learn, to try out and to experiment. The library facilities are brilliant, the art resources in the library – the magazines as well as the books are excellent. EMPLOYABILITY TEAM TIPS - PREPARING FOR AN INTERVIEW

Whether you're planning on applying for university, a part-time job alongside your studies or you're looking ahead to full-time employment after your studies, some universities and almost all employers will ask to interview you as part of the application process.

With the introduction of a more hybrid office/working-from-home approach during the Covid-19 pandemic, these interviews could take place face-to-face or via a video call, on platforms such as Microsoft Teams, Zoom or Skype.

So the big question is, how you should prepare? We've provided some top tips to help you be organised, well-equipped and confident for any interview.

1. Find out what the format of the interview will be

You need to find out whether the interview will be conducted via video call or face-to-face. If it's via video, it could be live or it could be pre-recorded.

Some universities or employers may ask you to record your answers to a set of questions that are presented on the screen. This can be difficult and feel quite impersonal but there are still plenty of ways you can adequately prepare, as we'll explain later.

Others may prefer to do a live interview. This is similar to a face-to-face one in that you will be interacting with another person, which may make it feel a little more natural.

If the interview is in person you can ask what to expect, such as how many people you'll be interviewed by, how long the interview may take and whether you will be asked to complete any tasks as part of the process. There are also other things to consider such as where the interview will take place. Which leads us to our next top tip...

2. Location, location

If the interview is in person, make sure to double check when and where the interview takes place, how you will travel to that location and how long it will take you to get there. Plan to arrive in plenty of time.

If you're interviewing via video link, it's important to be aware of your surroundings and make sure you have a good internet connection. You want to look professional, so make sure your background is quite neutral and don't sit in front of a window as it will cast you in a shadow, making it difficult for an interviewer to see you.

Finally, you need to be somewhere quiet, where you won't have any distractions. Perhaps you could arrange a room at College for your interview? If you're at home, speak to the people you live with so they know not to interrupt you.

3. Practise with a mock interview

A mock interview is a great way to practise your skills. This can easily be organised to test your camera, connection, lighting and location.

Ask a friend, mentor or an adviser from our Careers & Welfare team to do a mock interview with you. It needs to be someone you can rely on to get constructive feedback.

If you know the interview will be recorded, you can practise recording yourself answering some standard questions then watch yourself back to see how you perform on camera.

4. Other considerations

Even if you're at home you need to make sure you dress appropriately, as you would for a face-to-face interview.

Whether it's in person, live or recorded, use positive body language and remember to smile. Make sure you are not slouching and are sitting with good posture. Maintain good eye contact with the interviewers and show your enthusiasm.

With any interview, you should research the organisation and the role. Having this background knowledge and being able to work this into your interview will demonstrate that you are determined, proactive and that you have an interest in the organisation you are applying to.

It's perfectly acceptable to take notes into any interview to prompt you. These could be short phrases or key words that you want to work into your answers, or some of the research you've done into the organisation.
