WHAT TRAVEL **SUPPORT IS AVAILABLE?**

Are you a school leaver heading to college this September? Don't let travel be a barrier to your success.

We are here to help you get to any of our campuses using all public transport available, whether that's by bus if you're eligible for Our Pass or via our travel support package TMC Go. So, whether you're travelling to college or need to get to your work placement, we will help to get you there for free, anytime, seven days a week.*

OURPASS

If you're aged 16 or 17 on 31 August 2025 and live in Greater Manchester then you will be eligible for Our Pass.

Our Pass is a membership scheme for young people who live in Greater Manchester and helps school leavers get around the city. Those eligible have the chance to become a member – and potentially enjoy two things:

Free bus travel across Greater Manchester.

For a one-off £10 fee, members can travel on most local buses, any day of the week, for free. Members can also get half-price off-peak 1 day and weekend travelcards on Metrolink.

Membership unlocks exclusive offers and experiences.

These include discounts, special offers, free tickets, swimming and leisure passes, merchandise, taster sessions and much more.

Please note that Our Pass is not a College product but is available to students who enrol with us and are eligible.

TMCGO

For students aged 16-18 who are not eligible for Our Pass and/ or who live outside the Greater Manchester travel area there is support available through TMC Go.

If you're not eligible for Our Pass, The Manchester College will give you the same opportunities with TMC Go. TMC Go will operate on your college ID badge as a travel pass on bus transport only. TMC Go is there to support students with a range of travel options, so if travel by bus isn't feasible you can appeal to have your support adjusted to Metrolink or train. This is assessed on an individual case by case basis.

Are you eligible for TMC Go?

If you're aged 16 or 17 and live outside of Greater Manchester or aged 18 prior to 31st August 2025 then you won't be eligible for Our Pass, however you can apply to get travel support through TMC Go if you meet our criteria*:

- Your household income is less than £40,000 per year
- You are enrolled at The Manchester College and have good attendance.

Additionally, if you are eligible for Our Pass but are struggling to get to campus by bus or it takes too long we will look at alternative transport methods if you meet our criteria.

Struggling to travel by bus?

If you're aged 16-18 and your journey to college by bus just isn't feasible and/or you plan to travel by tram or train but are struggling to afford it, then we could help fund some or all of your travel to campus via train or tram with TMC Go.**

If eligible for enhanced support we will assess the best mode of transport for you. If travel by train or tram is a more suitable option then funding will be allocated based on specific criteria.

- * Our TMC Go offer applies to 2025/26 only and is subject to available funds, terms, conditions and eligibility.
- ** Eligibility criteria and terms and conditions apply.

All of the travel and parking schemes mentioned in this leaflet are subject to annual review in line with funding availability and each scheme will be reviewed and assessed before the start of each academic year. There is no guarantee that the benefits of any scheme will be continued from one academic year to the next.

How do I get travel support?

Accepted an offer with us?

If you are eligible and are aged 16 or 17 you can apply for Our Pass now so this will be ready when you enrol.

If you are aged 15 you cannot apply until the Our Pass system opens which is usually around June or July.

If you have any challenges in accessing your studies via bus with your Our Pass, please let us know as we may be able to support alternative modes of transport.

You can apply for TMC Go if and when you enrol, however this will take at least 24 hours to process and no travel will be paid for until the travel award has been awarded.

We are always looking at ways to improve our support and services to all our learners. As a result we are aiming to agree a new combined ticket for tram and bus, which would be loadable onto learners' college ID cards who require this.

We will hopefully have some more information for you as we get closer to your enrolment in September.

HOW TO TRAVEL AROUND MANCHESTER

As well as TMC Go and Our Pass there are several other city-wide initiatives to help students get across Manchester using public transport at either a discounted price or for free.

- Free buses run around the city every 10-15 minutes on weekdays and every 15-20 minutes on weekends.

- Choosing a combined Train and Tram Ticket allows you to travel free on Metrolink trams in Zone 1 if you have bought a rail ticket for travel from any Greater Manchester station to a city zone station -just request a Metrolink add-on free of charge when purchasing your rail ticket. - Save 1/3 on rail tickets when you purchase a yearly railcard (£30 for a year)
