


In September 2025 we will open brand new facilities for your course in a new fourstorey building next door to City Campus Manchester.

Study Programmes

We offer qualifications from Level 1 to Level 3, including T Levels.

If you haven't already obtained a Grade 4 GCSE in English or maths, you'll study to work towards achieving this qualification. This is a mandatory requirement and it's also essential you achieve this for many careers.

Employability

To prepare you for your future career, you'll take part in a range of 'employability' activities to equip you with the knowledge and experience of the careers available to you.

You'll be assigned an Employability Co-ordinator and will take part in a wide range of activities that will help you develop the knowledge, skills and behaviours you'll need to thrive in the workplace.

Industry Expertise

You will get the opportunity to take part in masterclasses and lessons delivered by industry experts, visits from guest speakers within the sector and industry-standard projects, that will see you working on the kind of tasks you'd be completing once you begin your career in the business industry.

Work Experience or Industry Placement

As part of your course you are required to take on external work experience. We will help you find a suitable placement. While there, you'll help with day-to-day tasks and shadow staff to develop the knowledge, skills and behaviours that are expected in the workplace and broaden your knowledge of the industry.

You may be able to apply for an industry placement offering a longer period of experience with a leading employer, depending on your course.

An industry placement gives you in-depth knowledge of the industry, allows you to gain hands-on experience and gives you an insight into career pathways.

With a placement, you're taking that all important first step onto the ladder; many of our students even go on to gain paid employment with their industry placement employer at the end of the year.

Work Related Activity

There are so many careers in the business sector and we want to help you explore as many as possible during your studies.

We organise lots of work-related activities to help you discover more about the opportunities that might be open to you. You could soon be taking part in activities such as:

- Hearing first-hand accounts from business leaders and entrepreneurs
- Masterclasses from leading employers and brands
- Trips to businesses both locally and nationally, to learn what it's like working in a business.





Study for a Technical Level (T Level) qualification in Business Management and Finance

T Levels are a new two year technical programme that provide you with a high-quality alternative to A Levels.

They have been developed in collaboration with employers, and combine theory, practical and classroom learning with a minimum 45 day industry placement. If you opt to take a T Level you will spend 20% of your time on an industry placement and 80% in the classroom.

After completing the course you can progress directly into work, on to a Higher Apprenticeship or even move on to study a university degree, as T Levels are awarded UCAS points.



T Award

Those successful in gaining a place on a T Level will be eligible for the 'T Award', a package of benefits that includes:

- → Access to industry standard laptop* (as appropriate)
- → Opportunity to take part in exciting college-wide competitions
- → Minimum 20% delivery by industry experts

Courses

Level 3 | T Level | Accounting City Campus Manchester | Two Years

If you're interested in a career in accounting with a range of possible specialisms then this course is perfect for you.

You'll develop an understanding of a broad range of issues relevant to the sector by studying topics such as the business environment, fundamentals of law and financial accounting, regulation, security and risk, and professional services. As well as this, we'll also help you to develop your research skills, project management, professionalism, and ethics within accounting.

Level 3 | T Level | Business Management and Administration City Campus Manchester | Two Years

If you have a brain for business and love getting stuck into the details of planning and management, then our Business Management and Administration T Level could be perfect for you.

You'll learn about large organisational structures and their event management processes while learning how to project manage more effectively. We'll help you to develop your leadership skills, financial management awareness and planning strategies needed for modern day business. As well as all that, you'll also study topics including business context, quality compliance and change management.

Level 3 | T Level | Finance City Campus Manchester | Two Years

The financial services industry is one of the largest employers in the UK. It is a diverse industry covering areas such as banking, insurance, and wealth management. Money, protecting our assets and our future wealth are important to all of us. This is a fantastic industry with growing opportunities, calling for a variety of skills from its staff.

This course will help you develop an understanding of a broad range of issues relevant to the sector, including; the business environment, fundamentals of financial accounting, data driven innovation, analytics, design thinking and professionalism with compliance and ethics.

For those who don't meet the entry requirements and would still like to pursue a T Level, there is the option of a one-year Level 2 T Level Foundation Year.

This Foundation Year will allow you to gain a qualification and move on to study one of our T Levels the following year.

Level 2 | T Level Foundation Year | Business Management, Finance and Accounting

City Campus Manchester | One Year

You'll learn how businesses are structured whilst gaining valuable industry skills by studying the key areas that employers are currently looking for skills in including organisational structures, event management, project management, leadership skills and finance as well as undertaking an industry placement.


Once you complete the qualification you'll be ready to progress on to a Business Management and Finance T Level the following year.

Level 1 | Introduction to Business

Harpurhey / Wythenshawe | One Year

Working with industry-standard tools and software, this course will help you develop the all-round technological skills required to move onto further studies in business.

You'll explore a variety of transferable and sector specific skills such as organisational skills, research, progression plans and teamwork as well as studying business industry-based projects.



Level 2 | Business Skills with Entrepreneurship

City Campus Manchester | One Year

Whether you want to set up your own company, help develop a family business or oversee a department in a large corporation, you'll need the same employability skills and knowledge of the business world to succeed. That's where this course can help.

You'll learn all about how businesses are created and structured, and the impact of different ownership models on both individual departments and the business as a whole. We'll help you to explore all the skills and techniques you need to effectively manage a business, from tracking spending and income to overseeing resources and deciding where they should be allocated.

Alongside all of this, you'll be developing a number of interpersonal skills and qualities that will help you in whatever career path you choose, including providing excellent customer service, being organised and working with others.

You can earn a Level 2 Award or Certificate, depending on the number of units you take, and you'll get the chance to work with large, well-respected businesses in Manchester on special projects.

Level 3 | Business Venture with Entrepreneurship

City Campus Manchester | Two Years

If you want to enhance your entrepreneurial skills even further and develop the insight, knowledge and abilities to stand out and succeed in any business situation, then this Level 3 qualification could be just the course for you.

Whether you're learning how to start a company from scratch or how multinational corporations operate, you'll look at a wide range of topics relevant to every aspect of business. You'll take a close look at human resource management and find out how different departments work together to ensure their activities benefit the business as a whole.

We'll also help you to understand globalisation and how it impacts international businesses, and cover a multitude of other topics, such as business law, finance and accounting. You'll even learn about marketing and the different methods used to promote brands.

The overall focus will be ensuring you're ready to start a career in the ever-competitive business world. In your second year you'll have the opportunity to specialise in the area of business that you enjoy and want to pursue, whether that's marketing, finance, law or if you prefer, you can continue to study the overall business landscape.

Study a Foundation Degree in Business Management


You'll cover a range of topics, including:
