HOW TO APPLY

STEP 1 Visit our website

Whether you want to apply to a course starting in January or any of our courses starting in early 2021, visit tmc.ac.uk and select either '16-18 – January Courses' or '19+ Adult – January Courses'.

STEP 2 Find your course

Browse our range of courses starting from January 2021 and select the course you'd like to study.

STEP 3 Apply or enquire online

Tap 'Apply Now' and follow the application process.

You will be asked to create an account using an active email address and to set-up a password. Once you have an account you will be able to track your application and subsequently enrol.

Alternatively, if you're not able to apply directly online, navigate to the 'Make an enquiry' section on the page to request more information.

STEP 4 Receive your offer

Once you have applied, and depending on the requirements of the course, you will receive a conditional offer of a place at the College via the applicant portal.

This just means that you've got a place on the course with us if you have the experience we've asked for.

STEP 5 Enrolment

Once you've submitted your application online, our enrolment team will be in contact to enrol you over the phone and give you more information about starting your course.

If you've applied to start in January, they will call you during the following weeks:

19+ Adults: W/C Monday 18 January

FUNDING

Depending on your course, age and income there are funding options available for most students to join our Centres of Excellence.

16-18 FUNDING

The most important thing to know about finance and funding if you're 16-18 years old, is that you won't have to pay any course fees or exam costs at The Manchester College.

During your time with us, there may be other things you have to pay for though, including travel to and from the College, food and drinks if you're on campus, and any additional costs for course kits or equipment.

To support you with this we offer the Study Programme Award (SPA)*.

16-18 Study Programme Award

You'll qualify for the SPA if:

- ▶ You're studying a 16-18 programme
- ▶ You have excellent attendance
- ▶ You put 100 percent into your work and behaviour: have a can-do attitude, be inclusive and kind, aim high and hit your deadlines

You will receive your SPA support every week you are in College or when you are off-site as part of your studies, for example, if you are on a work experience placement.

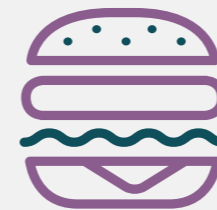

The award is made up of:

Bus Pass Award

If you are over 16 and under 18 on 31 August 2020 you can get free travel across the whole of Greater Manchester (GM) with Our Pass (ourpass.co.uk). We will even refund the £10 application fee.



Meal Support

You could be entitled to a meal award of up to £3.50 a day when in College or on a Work Placement.

Low income criteria applies. Plus you'll receive free tea and toast if you come into College before 8.45am.



Kit Award

If your course requires you to have a kit, you will receive a voucher to help with the cost up to a maximum of £75.

19+ ADULT FUNDING

If you're over the age of 19, some tuition and exam fees may apply, however, there are a number of opportunities to help you reduce or eliminate costs.

The funding you can claim will depend on your personal circumstances and the course you are studying.

Advanced Learner Loans

Advanced Learner Loans are available to you if you are 19 or over and you wish to study a Level 3 or 4 course. You must also have been a resident in the UK/EU for the last three years and be a UK/EU National or have settled status in the UK.

One benefit of an Advanced Learner Loan is that you don't have to repay your Advanced Learner Loan until you have finished your course and earn more than £26,575. Advanced Learner Loans are not means tested and there are no credit checks, and your loan will be paid directly to LTE Group –The Manchester College is part of LTE Group.

Plus, if you progress on to certain higher education courses you may not have to pay back your Advanced Learner Loan.

Fully Funded

If you are aged between 19 and 23 and don't have a current level 2 or 3 qualification OR you are receiving some income based benefits you may be able to be remitted for the course fees, meaning you pay nothing.

Self-Funded

Some of our courses require self-funding, however, you can choose to self-fund any of our courses and pay via direct debit.

Employer Funded

Your employer may wish to pay for your qualification as part of your ongoing development.

Additionally, you may be eligible to apply for an award to go towards your travel expenses and some fees.

19+ Adult Study Programme Award

The 19+ Study Programme Award is made up of four different elements: tuition fees, travel awards, exam fees and childcare.

The elements you can apply for will depend on your circumstances and the course you are studying, and your attendance will need to be 85% or over before we can issue any funding.

Tuition and exam fees

If you are eligible, you may be able to apply for a 19+ Study Programme Award to cover some or all of the cost of your course and exam fees.

Travel awards

Depending on your course timetable, you can apply for a System One travel pass.

Childcare

The maximum childcare funding available will be as follows:

Childcare funding for children aged up to two years old:

- You will be expected to pay 5% of the nursery place directly to the provider
- The College will pay your childcare provider a maximum of £150 per week

Childcare funding for children aged between two and 11 years old:

- The College will support any additional childcare hours above the Nursery Education Grant hours voucher up to a maximum of £150 per week, per child
- You will be expected to pay 5% of the nursery place directly to the provider

Where you have children both under and over two years of age, the maximum that the College will pay is £300 per week.

Any childcare costs incurred before you have official written confirmation from the College that childcare funding has been agreed and you have returned the signed contract will remain the learner's liability to pay the nursery provider.
